Sermon Series: Thankful Hearts & Generous Hands - Part

Message: A Thankful Heart

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 9:7-12 NRSV

As we begin our 2024 Stewardship Campaign and this series of messages, i invite you to take a moment to recall and reflect upon the people you are

thankful to have or have had in your life. What makes life worth living, through the struggles we often face, are the people we meet that impact our lives, for the better. At its best, the church is a community of people that create space for empowerment, healing, wholeness, acceptance, respect, and genuine compassion. Our charge, as people of faith, is to continue provide an avenue where multiple generations, cultures, and ethnicities can find a safe place to interact with the transformational love of God. Our stewardship campaign, therefore, is a call for us to commit our time, talent, and treasure toward that charge with thankful hearts and generous hands.

In our text, we find the Apostle Paul offering words of instruction to the church at Corinth about being thankful over begrudging and generous over miserly. Paul begins by reminding them that each of them must evaluate their own heart and base their stewardship on what is contained therein: "7 Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver" 2 Cor 9:7 NIV. Paul's statement challenged the Corinthians to evaluate why they were giving the time, talent, treasure. What was their heart's condition, temperament, attitude, and motivation for giving? Were they doing it reluctantly and begrudgingly? Were they doing it under compulsion, or a feeling of coercion? Were they doing it with ulterior motives and agendas? Were they doing it as a means of absolution for behaviors and conduct they knew were questionable? God loves those whose hearts of filled with cheer, joy, gratefulness, and thankfulness for they recognize the giving serves as an act of worship, a sign of spiritual maturity, and statement of faith. When we give from thankful hearts, we demonstrate our faithfulness and spiritual maturity, recognizing God as the source of all we have. When we give from thankful hearts, we confirm that we prioritize relationship with God over materialism

Our future plans include developing a "Family Center" where parents will have a comfortable space to experience our worship service via live stream in space that is hospitable for them.


GUIDING FORCE YOUTH GROUP Guiding Force Families met recently, making plans for scheduling and programs for the coming year.




