

SERMON SNIPPET:

Sermon: MORE THAN ANYTHING

Scripture: 1 John 51-5 NRSV Preacher: Rev. Dr. Anthony Hood

Gospel recording artist, Lamar Campbell & Spirit of Praise offer a moving testament with the song, "More Than Anything." Its chorus, a simplistic but powerful expression and affirmation: "I love you Jesus. I worship and adore you. Just want to tell you; Lord, I love you more than anything." The chorus of this song challenges us to examine our lives and whether our lives mirror the

sentiment expressed within it. Are we willing to put aside prioritizing our personal preferences for God's divine purpose? Are we willing to fully engage a life of servanthood, sharing God's love with others? Are we willing and committed to love grow more than anything?

In our text, we find the author of 1 John offering us simple truths: 1) If we love God, then we must love Jesus. 2) If we love God and Jesus, then we will do what they direct/teach us to do.3) Our faith will help us overcome the world. Truth #1 - If we love God, then we must love Jesus the two cannot be separated. This means we accept Jesus as savior, Lord, and redeemer. Jesus is the gate through which we come to God the creator. Jesus it the bridge that restores our relationship with God.

Truth #2 - If we love God, we cannot say we do not accept Jesus because Jesus is the embodiment of God's love for us. If we love God & Jesus, then we must do what they instruct/direct us to do, without finding it burdensome. Which does not mean we cannot struggle with our obligation, rather we cannot begrudgingly follow. Yes, it is hard, but the mature in faith see only the benefit not the hardship. That is how love works. Truth #3 - Our faith will help us overcome. How are we able to serve and live in obedience? Faith helps us look past our struggles to see possibly in the midst of our challenges. Faith helps us move past mediocrity to embrace the best of what God wants for us and through us. Faith is the linchpin for our deliverance, restoration, and peace. For we know that God has the last word on all things, even when that means victory does not come on this side.


