As people of faith, our participation in God's saving work is part of our responsibility as disciples of Jesus. It is not enough to simply secure our own soul's salvation if we are also not intentionally connecting with others. God has blessed us so that we, in turn, can bless others. Our scripture for this

morning is a familiar passage, most commonly referred to as: the great commission. Here we find the resurrected Jesus commending to his closest followers, the task of spreading the gospel. Jesus directs and charges us to go make (model & mentor) disciples, to help integrate them within the community of faith, and teach them what it means to be a mature disciple. The is the primary task/mission of the church is to duplicate then multiply itself to increase its impact. The work of duplication and multiplication takes full audience participation. Jesus had the eleven who accepted the call to spread the gospel, others answered the call, like Paul, and spread the gospel. Imagine the impact we can have when we fully participate.



GUIDING FORCE YOUTH GROUP MISSION WORK TRIP




